

CAN YOU HEAR THE SONG OF ETERNITY?

Where wast thou when I laid the foundations of the earth?

Declare, if thou hast understanding."

When the morning stars sang together, and all the sons

of God shouted for joy?" Job 38: 4 & 7

There is a beautiful story I recently read that I would like to share with you. The story touched me deeply and I believe there is a much deeper revelation for those of us who are beginning to hear our song which was sung for the whole of creation at the foundation of the earth. This is the song I am confident is calling and guiding each of us home. Home referring to the truth of our being and the place where we are in perfect harmony, unity, and oneness with the mind of God. The story comes from an article I read by Alan Cohen called, "They're Playing Your Song."

The story goes like this: when a woman in a certain African tribe knows she is pregnant, she and other woman of the village go into the wilderness together to pray and meditate until they hear the song of the child. They then sing the song out loud and teach it to the rest of the village. The song is sung at the birth of the child, when the child enters education, passes through the initiation to adulthood, and marries. They also sing the song when they believe the soul is about to pass from this world to the next life. The most interesting thing to me was that there is one more occasion when the tribe sings the song to the child. If at any time during his life the person commits a crime or a aberrant social act, they call the individual to the center of the village and form a circle around him and sing his song to him. They recognize that the correction for antisocial behavior is not punishment, but it is love and the remembrance of one's identity.

It is amazing the depth of spiritual understanding an African tribe has when most in the "Christian" world have not yet awakened to this beautiful and freeing truth. The tribe recognizes that every life has a vibration and purpose which can be revitalized and remembered by just singing their song to them. It seems the world of Christendom still holds the message of fear and punishment as their song to the world.

This story was so beautiful and meaningful to me but I see a song which is coming forth at this time greater than any of our individual songs. It is the corporate song of eternity which was sung at the foundation of the earth. It is a vibration of Oneness which is calling to us from the depth of our being to lay down all differences and open to the song within. Have you begun to hear the vibration of eternity's song?

The Bible tells us we are pilgrims and strangers in the earth and that this realm of time and space which we see with our physical eyes is not our true home. There is a song within each of us calling us to return, return, and live from the eternal, infinite realm from which we came.

As you first begin to hear this song it is like a quiet whisper which seems far away, but yet so familiar. It continues to vibrate within, becoming louder until you can hear with greater, and greater clarity the words of the song. The song begins with the vibration of

God's words as He looked at all He had created and declared that it was very good! Your natural mind starts to question what you are hearing and reasons, "How can this be truth when all around I see things in the world which surely *don't look good?*" But the song persists, it sings to you in the darkness and echoes to you in the morning light. You begin to be drawn to others who are hearing the same song and repeating the words, that all is very good and we are one. Gradually the things of this physical realm loose their hold and your consciousness raises to a higher dimension of rest the scripture calls heavenly places.

This is also the place Paul speaks of as he came to a revelation of the Lord in II Corinthians 12. He said he knew a man caught up into the third heaven (the number three is a numerical code referring to divine completeness, perfection, and resurrection; heaven being the dimension of pure God.) Paul is saying that this man, Paul himself, was caught up into the fullness of the mind of God called paradise. He began to hear the eternal song which he describes as unspeakable (inexpressible) words. We too are in the transition of being caught up into the fullness of God and hearing from the third heaven a song of such joy that it is inexpressible in this physical realm. This is the song which was placed in each of our hearts at the very foundation of the world.

This song of eternity is being heard once again by a man, but this time the corporate consciousness of the body Christ said he would raise on this third day . This corporate body is being caught up into the fullness of the mind of God as it begins to hear from a high vibration of perfection, completeness, and joy unspeakable. It cannot be heard with the natural ear, nor be expressed by mere words, but it must be heard and understood by the spirit within each and every man. Can you hear the song? Can you feel the vibration which is drawing you up, up, and away from the Adamic dream of separation, fear, condemnation, and duality?

Jesus Christ heard this song and it kept reminding him of his purpose and destiny. He heard it as He was being forsaken by the ones He loved. He listened intently to this song of eternity as they accused Him, beat Him, and finally as they crucified Him. Because He was hearing and receiving only from the mind of God he was able to say, "Forgive them for they know not what they do." They have not yet heard the eternal song of love, but only the one of accusation, judgment, jealousy and condemnation.. The vibration He was listening to had defeated and brought to silence the low vibration of that Adamic song forever. No longer could He be tempted with the things of this world nor could death have any hold on Him. This song of eternity had brought Him into the realm of oneness where there was no reality but God! In this realm there is no beginning or end. It is the eternal realm from which all of creation came forth. The limitless, eternal realm of the law of love, or God. This is the song of eternity which all of us must hear, the song of unconditional, infinite love singing within us.... the song which reminds us of the blueprint of our true identity and lets us know all is very good because we are one, I in you and you in Me, perfect in ONE! Can you hear ...they're playing OUR SONG!
