

ON A CLEAR DAY
YOU CAN SEE FOREVER

Religion, in the past, called certain songs secular or worldly. Now, these same songs seem, in many instances, to preach the true Gospel. Many songs, movies, children's stories and rhymes, when looked at through the eye of the Spirit, proclaim truth. Things we have been told to *stay away from, been afraid of* for our children, in reality, are preaching greater truth than many doctrines which have come out of a religious system.

The saying, "beauty is in the eye of the beholder," is very true! Paul says it clearly in Romans 14:14; "I know and am persuaded by the Lord Jesus, that there is nothing unclean of itself, but to him that esteemeth anything to be unclean, to him it is unclean." We have been looking through eyes, which have seen a mixture, instead of the singleness of our God. In Mathew 6:22, it tells us that the light of the body is the eye. That which brings our physical bodies into being fully light is our Spiritual view; that is to say, how we see and perceive things through the eye of the Spirit as opposed to through the eyes of the physical. It then goes further to say, "if thy eye be single, the whole body shall be full of light." We have two physical eyes, which are a picture for us that physically, in the natural world, we only see things through double vision. What we perceive through our physical eyes is not truth. The eye of our Spirit is single! We see all things having it's origin in God. We see all things clearly through that single eye and it fills our physical bodies with light!

The blind man in Bethsaida who was brought to Jesus is a picture for us today. Jesus spit on his eyes, putting the DNA of God on those eyes, and asked the man what he could see. First, the man saw men as trees walking. He began to see through the eye of the Spirit the true origin of all mankind. All men are a tree company-a planting of the Almighty God. Then, as Jesus touched him the second time, and made him look up to see true heavenly identity, he was restored, or made whole, and he saw all mankind clearly! This man was looking into the very eye of the CLEAR DAY HIMSELF!

You see, Jesus Christ is that Clear Day. In that Clear Day you can see forever! You can see with a Spirit eye, which is single. A Spiritual eye sees eternity in the heart of every man. This is Eternal life, to know or to get a revelation, of the One true God and Jesus Christ. When your eye becomes single and you get that revelation, you step out of the realm of physical sight into the realm of the CLEAR DAY, or the Sprit. You will be like John, who was on the Isle of Patmos in the Spirit, and you will see clearly the revelation of Jesus Christ! You then see from the perspective of the Spirit, or the Clear Day of Eternity.

Hear with Spiritual ears the words of this song and SEE how God uses *all things* to declare Himself:

The words "arise and look around you" takes us right to Isaiah 60:1. It says "arise, shine: for your light is come and the glory of the Lord is risen upon thee." As we get a revelation of our true identity, we begin to arise and shine with Christ life. It does *astound us* when we see our true origin is God. It begins to quicken in us, that our very Being does outshine every star because we are One with true light, the Son. We begin to hear clearly the voice of God from inside of us, a voice which guides, leads, and directs us into the fullness of eternity.

We have entered that CLEAR DAY! You are now in that Clear Day, manifesting your light into the world. In and through this Clear Day, you too, can see forever, and ever, and ever, and evermore.
